OUTLOOK FOR CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEE LEADERSHIP in the 118th Congress

The 118th Congress-elect will begin to organize within weeks of the election, setting off a real-time musical chairs of committee leadership. In the Senate, where seniority generally dictates the gavel, the dizzying array of possibilities can be clarified by senators indicating their respective intentions ahead of time. In the House, however, gavels are generally the result of campaigns (with a select few Speaker-appointed), determined by the selection of a steering committee and/or votes of the entire conference (GOP) and caucus (Democrats) as swearing-in day approaches. Further, GOP term-limits, which are established by Conference rules, may be extended to the full House in a GOP majority; adding further complication is the possibility of granting waivers as well as the likelihood of a GOP-led House potentially removing certain Members from preferred committees once the 118th Congress convenes. The below represents our informed speculation based on "known knowns," assuming a switch in the House majority, with further clarification provided in the weeks to come.
